Re: Vacancy for Community Council Representative on Ysgol Bodfari Governing Body.

A vacancy for the Community Council representative will arise from 3rd March 2018 as Mrs Naomi Ludhe Thompson's term of office comes to an end. It has been customary in the past for this representative role to be shared between the two Community Councils however Aberwheeler Community council have advised that none of their members are able to take on this commitment at this time. It would therefore be appropriate for a member of Bodfari community Council to take this on.

The role is an interesting and rewarding one and lasts for four years. The minimum requirement is attendance at at least 3 out of 5 Full Governing Body Meetings per year, having a Police Check (DBS) in accordance with Child Protection Procedures, being a participating member of other sub committees to be chosen with the incumbents' particular interests and skills in mind, and participation in a number of basic training courses usually held on line. As a governing body we offer a mentoring support to all new governors who are more than welcome to join us. The role of the Governing Body is essentially a strategic one, operational matters are the responsibility of the Head Teacher and her staff.
