Croeso i lythyr newyddion cyntaf Cyngor Cymuned Bodffari 2024.

Fel un sy'n byw yn y pentref, efallai nad ydych yn ymwybodol fod gennym Cyngor Cymuned. A gaf fi gyflwyno fy hun, fy enw yw Julie a fi yw Cadeirydd y Cyngor.

Mae gen i weithwyr ffantastig ac egniol – Is-Gadeirydd – Philip a chynghorwyr, Julie, Martin, Sue, Rebecca a'n Clerc prysur a threfnus, Heather. Mae mwy o wybodaeth amdanom ar ein gwefan.

Cawsom ein apwyntio i weithio drosoch i wneud penderfyniadau i wella'r pentref gan ddefnyddio swm bychan o arian gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Mae'r cyngor yn cyfarfod ar ail Ddydd Mawrth o'r mis (ond nid mis Awst) ac mae'r cyfarfodydd ar agor i bawb mewn person neu drwy linc. Rydym yn cyfarfod yn yr Eglwys, yr Ysgol ac yn Dinorben (Ystafell Breifat) yn eu tro.

Mae gan Bodffari grwp o weithwyr caled sy'n trefnu digwyddiadau i godi arian trwy gydol y flwyddyn.

Trefnwyd Ras Hwyaidd (a chodwyd £1000 I Hosbis Sant Cyndeyrn), Noson Lobscows, Te Prynawn, Noson Caws a Gwin, Boreon Coffi, Pimms Yn Y Parc yn ogystal ag achlysuron eraill.

Erbyn hyn, mae gennym ni bysrdau a chadeiriau I Babell y Pentref (yn defnyddio pres a godwyd gan y Grwp Cymuned ac arian loteri). Mae hyn yn golygu y gall y Babell ei ddefnyddio ar gyfer nifer o achlysuron gwahanol. Bydd nifer ohonoch yn ymwybodol bod y Babell wedi chwythu l'r gwifrau trydan ac felly gorfodwyd inni brynu un Newydd gyda phres insiwrans. Rydym yn ddiolchgar I Mr. Glazebrook am storio'r Babell inni yn ei gartref. Edrychwn yn awr am cynhwysydd l'w storio ac rydym yn edrych am rywun sydd a darn o dir.

Hefyd cofiwch am y Boreon Coffi ar Ddydd Iau olaf y mis, Caws a Gwin, Ras Hwyaidd er budd San Cyndeyrn, Parti Haf San Steffan ac ar y 5ed o Fai, prynhawn/hwyr yn Tyn y Nant, lle bydd bwyd, bar ac adloniant. Gosodir map newydd wrth fynedfa'r parc ac mae cerameg o'r pentref yn cael ei leoli ar waelod Maes y Graig wrth yr hysbysfwrdd.

Welcome to the first Bodfari Community Council BCC newsletter of 2024.

As a resident of the village, you may be aware that the Community Council exists, or then again, you may not! Either way, as way of a brief introduction, my name is Julie and I am the Chair of BCC.

Working alongside me is a collection of fantastic and enthusiastic local residents (Vice Chair Philip, and councillors Julie, Martin, Sue and Rebecca and our super organised and hard working Clerk, Heather (without whom we would all be lost) – more details of all of us can be found on the BCC website), we have been appointed to act on your behalf to make improvements and decisions regarding the village and to use the small amount of money we get from Denbighshire County Council to enhance the village.

The council meet on the second Tuesday of every month (excluding August) and meetings are open to all, both in person or through a meeting link. We rotate between the church, school and the Dinorben (private dining room).

Bodfari has a fabulous team of hard-working villagers who organise many fundraising events throughout the year and are playing a vital role in the re-ordering of the church.

The community organised a duck race (which raised £1000 for St Kentigerns Hospice), a hot pot supper, afternoon tea, cheese and wine, coffee mornings, Pimms in the park and numerous smaller events.

We have new tables and chairs for the village marquee (bought using monies raised by the community group and some lottery funding) which means the marquee can be used for a variety of different events. Many of you will know that the marquee was blown into the electricity wires and had to be replaced but thankfully the insurance covered the cost. We are grateful to Mr Glazebrook for allowing us to store the Marquee at his home; we are looking to have a storage container for the marquee and furniture so if anyone has a spare patch of land, we can store it on, please let us know.

Last year the council:

- Installed new goal posts and swings in the park.
- Organised the vegetable, sunflower and pumpkin competitions
- Maintained the floral displays in the 'welcome to Bodfari' planters and arranged regular park maintenance
- Ensured community assets were adequately insured and 'fit for purpose'

This Year

This year the village has a number of events in the planning stage and there will be others throughout the year so keep an eye on the village notice boards and our social media accounts.

Naturally the annual summer vegetable and sunflower competitions and the best carved pumpkin and biggest pumpkin competition around Halloween will once again draw in the crowds but the village will also be hosting monthly coffee mornings (last Thursday of the month), Cheese and Wine events, annual Duck Race in aid of St Kentigerns, St Stephens Summer Party and on 5th May and afternoon/evening event with entertainment, food and a bar at Tyn Y Nant
